**What is CERT?** CERT stands for Community Emergency Response Team. A CERT is a group of people that are organized to work as a group to respond to disasters that impact their homes, businesses, and neighborhoods.

The CERT program provides lectures, films, and hands-on training for participants over an eight (8) week period. Classes are held once a week in the evenings. The program is offered at \$25.00 and is open to all Santa Ynez, Solvang and Bulletin residents age 18 and up.

The CERT program is designed to be practical, interesting and fun. While the program is interactive, there are no special physical requirements to participate in the program.

CERT is sponsored by Orfalea's Aware and Prepare Program and the Cities of Solvang and Buellton. All classes are taught by emergency management, American Red Cross, Fire Safety Experts and Santa Barbara County Sheriff's instructors.
