- Free for residents; no appointment needed
 - Fee for business waste; call to schedule an appointment
 - Only 15 gal or 125 lbs of hazardous waste accepted per trip
 - NO trash or green waste accepted during the event

Examples of Household Hazardous Waste Accepted:

Automotive fluids, batteries, cleaners, gardening supplies, fluorescent bulbs, medications, needles*, paint, pool chemicals, etc. (*Needles must be delivered in puncture-proof containers; free containers are available at the transfer station during normal operating hours)

NO explosive, radioactive, or biological material; NO ammunition or smoke alarms; NO controlled substances

Examples of Electronics Accepted:

Computers, printers, fax machines, TVs, VCRs, DVD and CD players, radios, telephones, microwaves, etc.

NO refrigerators, stoves, or other large appliances; NO satellite dishes

Note that electronics are also collected at the Transfer Station during normal hours of operation, Tues-Sat 8:30 am to 4:00 pm
