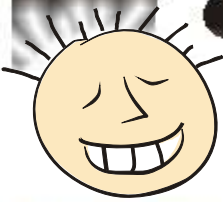

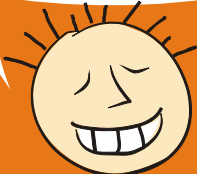
"Chicago" Musical
