Proposed Scope & Fee: Corridor Study for the Avenue of Flags Re-alignment

RBF will build on the land use and circulation concept illustrated in the Draft Buellton Vision Plan and prepare up to three alternative preliminary plans for the re-alignment of the Avenue of Flags. The preliminary plans will also illustrate potential southbound U.S. 101 exit and entrance ramp reconfigurations, Central Avenue traffic calming improvements, preliminary roundabout design at three intersection locations, potential impacts to properties, and layout of parking and local roadway connections. Existing and future traffic volumes provided by the City will be used to confirm adequacy of proposed circulation modifications. A preliminary estimate of construction costs will be prepared for the proposed preliminary circulation plans.

RBF will prepare this task for a fee of \$14,600 budgeted as follows:
