

## A Note from Mayor Holly Sierra.....

Summer is here with these wonderful long sunny days and cool nights. There are days, though, that can get really warm - actually hot!

PG&E is working to help curb fires due to extreme heat. To this end, they are going to perform Public Safety Power Shutoffs. This is new, and we are working with PG&E to provide a game plan for residents and businesses. PG&E will contact account owners with as much warning as they can. Shutoffs could occur when high winds or high temperatures are coming to our community such as sundowners. Power will be shut off in blocks, so that could mean an area as far north as Los Alamos through the Valley.

There may not be much notice given, so it's very important to be ready. Keep gas in your vehicle, keep filled water bottles in your freezer (it will keep items frozen a little longer) and have flashlights and candles handy. Unplug unnecessary appliances so surges cannot occur. We've been told that these outages might last anywhere from a few hours up to 4 days. Buellton and Solvang city staff are trying to find cooling centers. As of now we've been told that the Chumash Casino has a generator and it will stay air conditioned. As for public works; there are generators to keep water and wastewater functioning.

You can call PG&E at this number: 1-866-743-6589 to be put on an update list. Our City continues to work on plans to make these shutoffs easier to deal with, but please remember what makes Buellton so special. We care about each other. If these incidents happen we may not have phone service. Please check on your neighbors. Stay in touch, share what you can and we'll get through this. Please check the City website occasionally and we'll update any information we have.


