There's a lot going on in our beautiful community. This is what you need to know.

We are finalizing plans for a median on Avenue of Flags. It's the median in front of our Chamber of Commerce and will be paved for parking. It will have trees and shrubs and be designed to bring in car shows and a farmer's market - like we used to have. It could also be used for art shows or community get-togethers. Check out the plans on our City Council's 4/23/19 packet or come into the Planning Department.



Our library is going from Santa Barbara to Goleta management. Our staff will be the same but your library cards need to be replaced. Stop by the library, meet our incredible staff that will continue working in Buellton under the Goleta library's umbrella and get a new card! Our staff and volunteers also have to recode every book, dvd and magazine in the building - they need more volunteers! Go in and sign up to help!

We're going to start our Circulation plan this year and we need input from the community. I know I'm jumping the gun since this won't come up till the end of the year, but the City is talking (again) to Caltrans about Hwy 246 and what I need now is input for the area on the highway from Riverview to La Lata. Caltrans has already planned to put in a median from La Lata to Twin Oak with a left turn lane. Slowly but surely changes are happening!

We've had a few retirements from the City in the last few months. Our Recreation Program Coordinator Barbara Knecht is retiring at the end of June. Our City Manager Marc Bierdzinski is also retiring after 15 years with the City. Please stop by and wish them well!

What Do I Do with Used Motor Oil??

If you change your motor oil and filters at home, be sure to: Use an durable plastic oil collection/drainer container with secure tight fitting lids to collect, store and transport your oil to the nearest state certified used oil collection center. Within the SYV, the state certified used oil collection centers are located at:

- (1) SYV Recycling and Transfer Station, 4004 Foxen Canyon Road
- (2) Jim Vreeland Ford, 340 East Highway 246
- (3) O'Reilly Auto Parts, 270 East Highway 246
- (4) Rio Vista Chevrolet, 390 East Highway 246
- (5) Waste Management, 97 Commerce Drive

Place cardboard under your drip pan to prevent spills. If a spill occurs, clean up the spill using dry methods (absorbent, sweep) rather than rinsing down areas.

Do not mix motor oil with any other vehicle fluids. If the motor oil is accidentally mixed with other fluids, take the mixed oil to the local hazardous waste collection facility and/or to the next local household hazardous waste collection event.

Keeping Buellton Beautiful Public Nuisances Designated—Debris Accumulation (BMC 8.04.030.B.3)

Unless you have a valid construction permit, lumber, trash, salvage materials, rubbish, broken concrete, containers, appliances, furniture, equipment, machinery parts, scrap, dismantled autos or any other junk stored or deposited on your property that is visible from the public right of way is prohibited. This includes items that constitute a fire hazard or which adversely affects the aesthetic or olfactory nature of the area.
