There are concerns that homeless encampments in the Lompoc Riverbed will be vacated by June and cause encampments to move east towards Buellton. The Sheriff's Office is actively working with Chief Walsh, social services, AmeriCorps and private groups to find solutions to this community issue. Deputies have been working with AmeriCorps on average once a week to make efforts to identify people and to find solutions to the problem. This will be an on-going detail to find solutions that work for local communities and the individuals being displaced. This effort involves multiple agencies and will likely be a lengthy process. As your Police Chief I will work closely with city staff and keep you updated on the process.
